PROGRAM SUMMARY

In Louisville, GEO Reentry Services provides comprehensive treatment programs in a non-residential setting tailored to meet individual participant's risks and needs. At the foundation of GEO Reentry's treatment is evidence-based programming designed to address criminogenic needs as identified through the assessment process. The nonresidential reentry model includes the following: Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), life skills training, job readiness and employment assistance, community connections, education services, aftercare, Moral Reconation Therapy® (MRT), and family relationship reconciliation. Programming is delivered through group and individual sessions.

The following reflects 2019 (January 1, 2019 – December 31, 2019) program data for the Louisville Metro Reentry Service Center (RSC) in Kentucky.

EMPLOYMENT GAINS

A goal of the RSC is to assist participants with securing employment and enrollment in school.

The RSC increased participant employment by **20 percentage points**, on average from intake to exit.

RISK REDUCTION ASSESSMENT SCORES

In 2019, the Louisville DRC helped participants cut their risk of recidivism in half from 86% to 44%, a **49**% reduction in risk, on average.

COST AVOIDANCE ANALYSIS

GEO Reentry programming at the RSC saves money for the City of Louisville and its citizens. Transforming offenders into productive members of the community avoids costly incarceration and enhances public safety.

In 2019, the Louisville Metro RSC saved the metro jail a total of 14,889 bed days resulting in over \$820,000 in savings.


