PROGRAM SUMMARY

In Louisville, GEO Reentry Services provides comprehensive treatment programs tailored to meet individual participant's risk and needs. At the foundation of GEO Reentry's treatment is evidence-based programming designed to address criminogenic needs as identified through the assessment process. The Louisville Metro Reentry Service Center (RSC) program model includes: Cognitive Behavioral Treatment (CBT), job readiness and employment assistance, community connections, aftercare, and Moral Reconation Therapy® (MRT). Programming is delivered through group and individual sessions. The RSC is designed to be part of the solution in changing behavior and reducing recidivism in Kentucky.

The following reflects 2021 (January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021) program data for the Louisville Metro RSC.




LSI-R RISK REDUCTION ASSESSMENT SCORES

The RSC uses the Level of Service Inventory-Revised (LSI-R) tool to identify participants'risk and needs and the likelihood of recidivism. During the reporting period, programming at the Louisville RSC helped participants **reduce their risk scores by an average of 30%**, which correlates to a similar reduction in the probability of recidivism.¹ (n=19)



SERVICES ATTENDANCE

Below are RSC participation results for the reporting period. Participants demonstrated a high degree of accountability by attending the center as scheduled while working towards behavior change.



COST AVOIDANCE ANALYSIS

In 2021, the RSC continued to save money for the City of Louisville and its citizens. Transforming participants into productive members of the community avoids costly incarceration participants, while enhancing public safety.

EMPLOYMENT GAINS

A goal of the RSC is to assist participants with securing employment and enrollment in school. During the reporting period, the RSC had an average annual employment rate of 90%, with monthly averages ranging from 78% to 97%.
