LYCOMING COUNTY REENTRY SERVICE CENTER REDUCES RECIDIVISM AND GENERATES COST SAVINGS



PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Lycoming County Reentry Service Center (RSC) provides evidence-based reentry programming and electronic monitoring services to probationers and parolees on community supervision.

Based on the data provided by the Lycoming County Adult Probation Office, the Lycoming RSC has helped to reduce recidivism, alleviate prison over-crowding, and increase return on taxpayer investment.

COST-EFFECTIVE PROGRAMS

The electronic monitoring program saves money for Lycoming County and its citizens. Placing individuals on community supervision diverts offenders from prison and generates savings by reducing incarceration days.

Since 2015, the Lycoming RSC saved the Lycoming County Prison a total of 73,946 days, resulting in over \$5,100,000 in savings.

RECIDIVISM

According to a 2019 analysis conducted by the Lycoming County Adult Probation Office, the Lycoming RSC is producing positive results in reducing recidivism. The analyzed data for 201 individuals, who graduated the RSC program between 2015 and 2019, to determine the impact that programming has on recidivism and cost savings.




A REDUCTION IN PRISON OVERCROWDING GENERATES SAVINGS

A goal of the RSC is to help Lycoming County reduce costly incarceration rates and prison overcrowding by diverting individuals from prison. This helps to preserve correctional funds and save money for tax-paying citizens.


Since 2015, the RSC has helped reduce costs by 82%.



Since 2015, the RSC has helped to reduce the average daily population (ADP) at Lycoming County Prison by 37% and keep the population below total capacity year over year.



Since 2015, the RSC has helped lower overcrowding transfers by 90%.
